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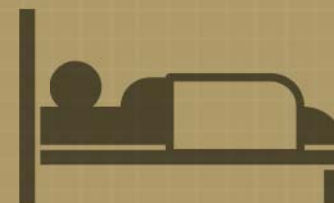

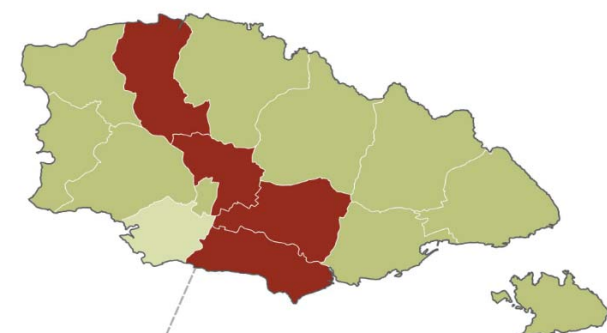

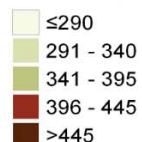

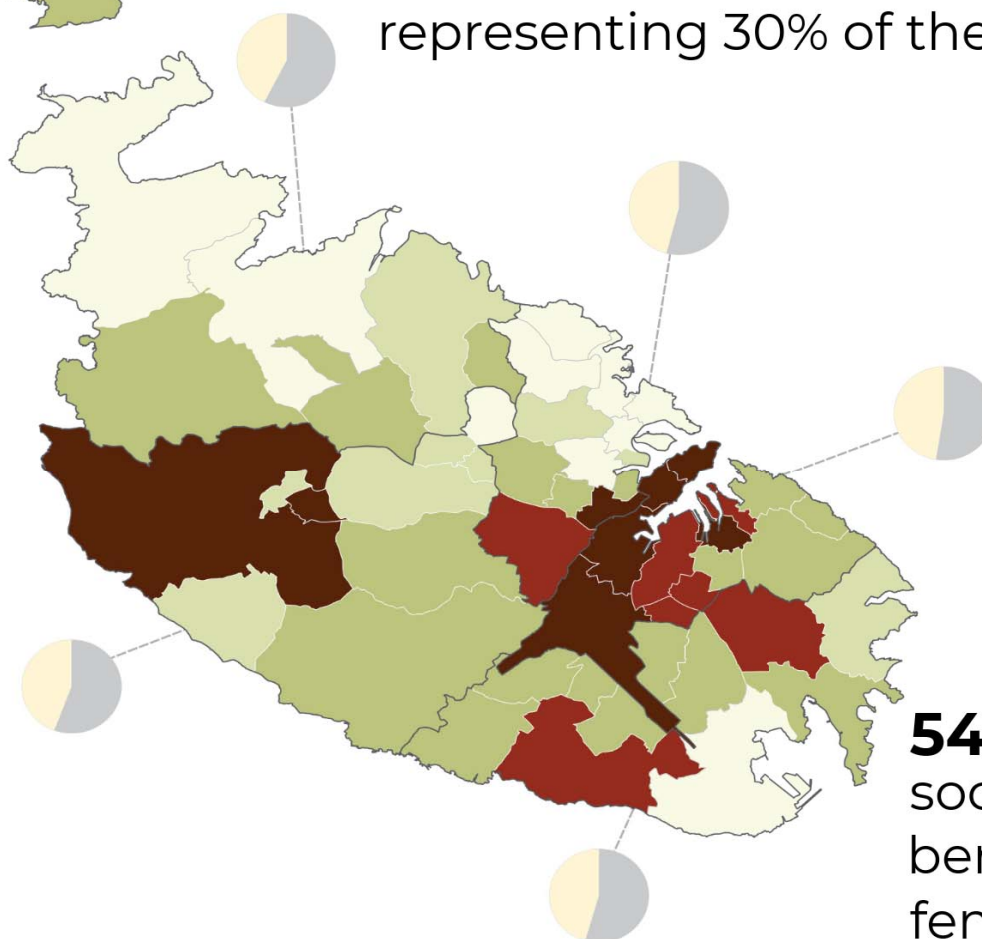
In 2016, **165,815** persons were in receipt of one or more social security benefits, representing 30% of the population.

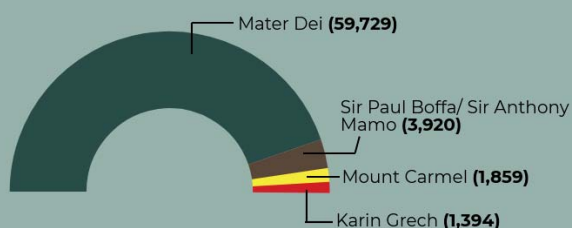
